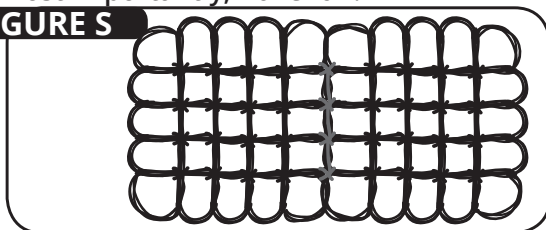
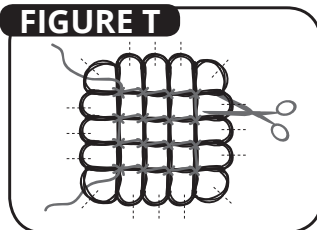

Weaving Widget (Pk/6)**Connecting and Finishing Ideas:**

- To connect Weaving Widget™ squares, lay two squares next to each other and tie the same crisscross knots at the four intersections (see Figure S). Connect as many squares together as you would like to make placemats, scarves or blankets.
- Try cutting each of the outside loops to create fringe on your square (see Figure T). This makes a great coaster or a pretty decoration to dress up a plain sweater.
- Experiment with many different colors and combinations of colors. The Weaving Widget™ creates a square similar in structure to a crocheted "Granny Square". Look for "Granny Square" Projects you can convert into Weaving Widget™ projects. Most importantly, Have fun!

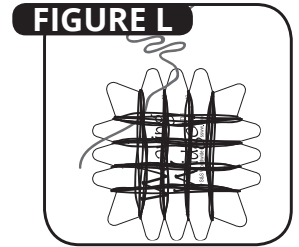
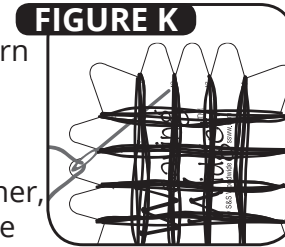
- Yarn (at least 11- 1/2 yds)
- Plastic Yarn Needle
- Scissors
- Ruler

INSTRUCTIONS:

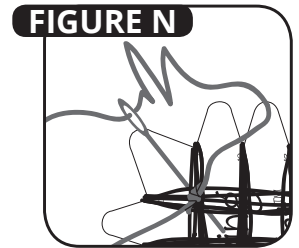
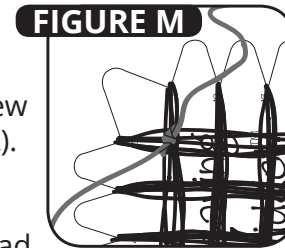
1. Cut a length of yarn 10 yds long. Hold one end of the yarn on the back side of the Weaving Widget™ (tape in place if desired). Bring the yarn up through the slot labeled 1 (see Figure A).
2. Bring the yarn down across the widget and down at slot 2 (see Figure B).
3. Bring the yarn up at slot 3 (see Figure C) and down again at slot 4 (see Figure D). Continue in this manner until you go down at slot 8.
4. Bring the yarn around the corner and up at slot 9 (see Figure E).
5. Turn the widget a 1/4 turn to the left (see Figure F).
6. Bring the yarn down at slot 10 (see Figure G). Continue weaving until you get to slot 16 (see Figure H).
7. Continue turning a 1/4 turn and weaving in the same manner until you can count 4 loops on the back of each widget finger (see Figure I).
8. Tie the two ends of the yarn together around the back of the corner finger.



9. Cut a 1 1/2 yard piece of yarn and thread it onto a yarn needle.

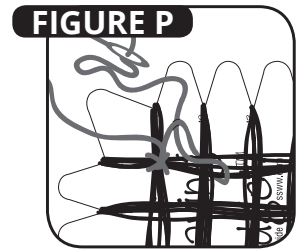
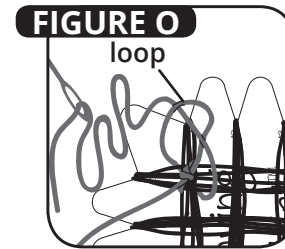


10. Starting at the top left corner, thread the needle under the first inter-section of yarn (see Figure K).



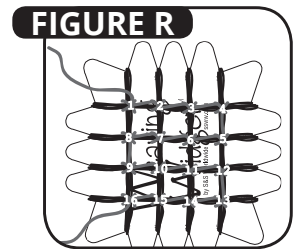
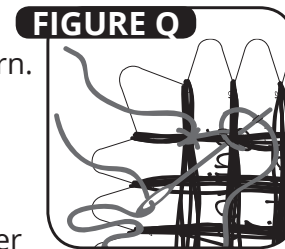
11. Pull the yarn until only a few inches remain (see Figure L). Tie a knot (see Figure M).

12. At the top left corner, thread the needle under the first intersection of yarn (see Figure N).



13. Bring the needle up and through the loop (see Figure O). Pull tight.

14. Thread the needle under the next inter-section of yarn. Bring the needle up and through the loop as in step 13 (see Figure P).



15. Repeat step 14 on the other diagonal to complete the knot (see Figure Q). Pull tight.

16. Continue tying knots around each intersection following the layout in Figure R.

17. Bend the widget on the crease to release the weaving. Work in ends with yarn needle.
