Authentic Teepee (Pk/24)

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE STARTING



YOUR KIT CONTAINS:

- Oil Pastels
- Glass Beads
- Kraft Paper
- Glue
- Wood Dowels
- Jute
- Cardboard Circle
- Crayons

AGE GROUP: 8 and up
PROJECT TIME: 60 minutes

YOU WILL NEED:

- Scissors
- Pencil
- Paper Towels

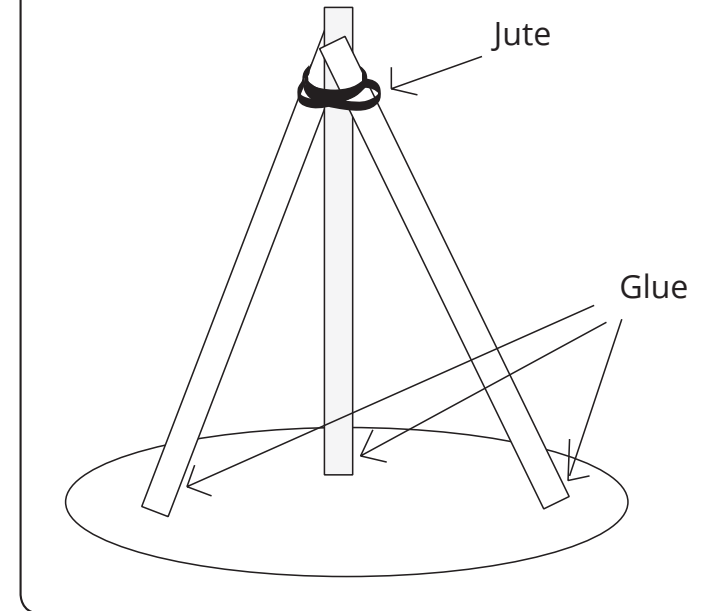
PROJECT INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Select 3 wooden dowels and tie the ends together with jute (see Figure A).
2. Glue the other ends of the wooden dowels onto the cardboard circle (see Figure A). Make sure to glue the dowels near the edges of the cardboard circle. Let dry.
3. Trace the tepee pattern onto the Kraft paper and cut out. Make photocopies of this template and distribute to each crafter.
4. Crinkle up the Kraft paper into a ball and flatten out, to add authentic/aged look.
5. Slightly tear all the edges of the tepee opening (see Figure B) starting at the bottom going 3/4 of the way up.
6. Plan out your design and color it in. We have included some ideas.
7. Wrap the Kraft paper around the wooden dowels (see Figure B). Glue the edges together at the top of the tepee. Let dry overnight.

TIP: Place the palm of your hand on top of the 3 dowels and push down while your fingers hold the paper flap closed near the top. Hold this position a minute or two. It will help the tepee flap stay closed at the top area.

8. Apply glue onto areas on the tepee and shake on glass beads. Shake off excess. Let dry.

TIP: Applying the beads over a tray or bowl will help keep the beads from rolling onto the floor.
