## Snowman Pals (Pk/24)

### YOUR KIT CONTAINS:

- Glue
- Snowman Parts
- Brushes
- Red Felt
- Glitter Glaze
- Markers
- Orange Foam Sheet

**AGE GROUP: 8 and up**  
**PREP TIME: 10 minutes**  
**PROJECT TIME: 45 minutes**

### YOU WILL NEED:

- Scissors
- Containers for Glitter Glaze
- Ruler

## PREP INSTRUCTIONS:

Cut twenty-four 3/4" x 12" strips from the red felt. Cut the orange foam sheet into 24 2" x 2" squares.

## INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Take your sheet of snowman parts and carefully punch out all pieces. (see highlighted parts in Figure A).

2. Use the markers to color one side of the hat and hat base. Color both sides of the arms. **TIP:** As you color, the piece may curl. Don't worry, as it dries it will uncurl.

3. Referring to Figure A for part identification, fold snowman 1 and 2 in half on the crease line. Unfold.

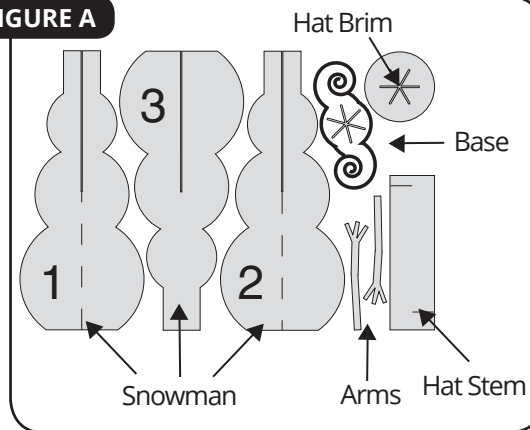
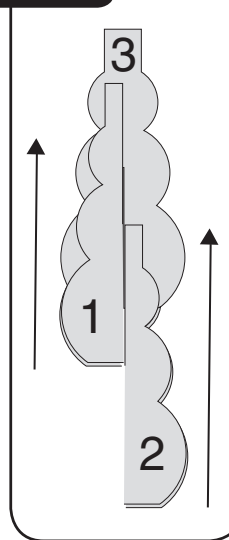
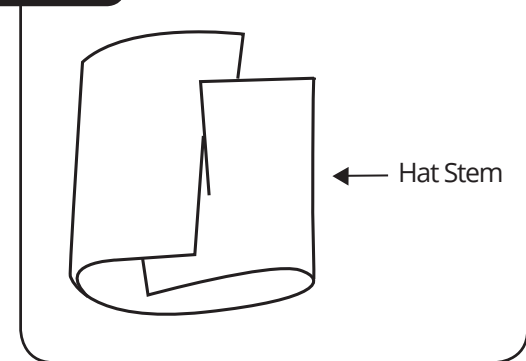
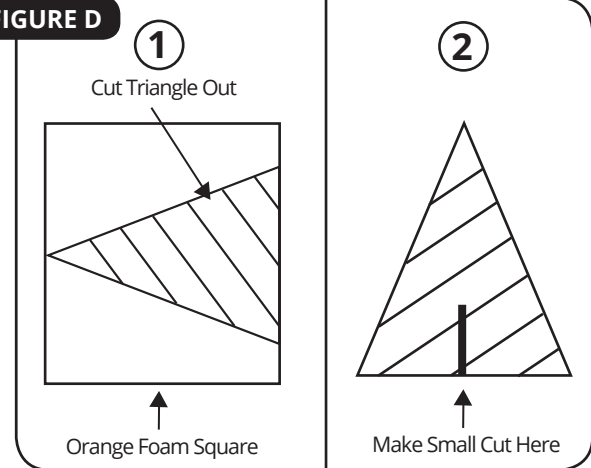
4. Hold snowman 3 in one hand and insert snowman 1 and 2 into the slot in snowman 3 (see Figure B).

5. Take the hat brim and bend center triangles up so you can slide it down over the top of the snowman's head and into place.

6. Bend the hat stem to form a tube and interlock the slits (see Figure C).

7. Slide the stem down over the top of the snowman's head into place.

8. Apply small amount of glue to center of the base and place snowman bottom in the center of the base over the glue and let dry. This will help hold the body pieces in place and stop them from moving around.

9. Glue arms in place. Let dry. **TIP:** Careful, the glue may cause the marker to bleed onto the body.

10. Cut a triangle out of the orange foam square. Make a 1/2" cut in the center of the triangle base (see Figure D).

11. Use the cut in the base of the foam triangle as a slot to attach as a "carrot like" nose to the front of the snowman's face.

12. Using the glitter glaze and a brush, paint glitter glaze onto selected areas of your snowman. **TIP:** Don't forget to wash out your brush when you're done so you can reuse it!

13. Using markers, draw on your snowman's eyes, hands and mouth as you wish.

14. Take your strip of red felt and tie it around the neck of your snowman as a scarf and you're done! **TIP:** You may wish to make small cuts in each end of the felt as fringe.
