Christmas Cuties Stain-a-Frames (Pk/18)

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE STARTING



YOUR KIT CONTAINS:

- Plastic Frames
- Stained Glass Paint
- Acrylic Paint
- Brushes

YOU WILL NEED:

- Scissors
- Paper Towels
- Eyedropper (optional)

AGE GROUP: 8 and up

PREP TIME: 5 minutes

PROJECT TIME: 30 minutes

INSTRUCTIONS:

1.
 - a. Be sure the sections of the frame that are to be painted are clean and free of dust.
 - b. The stained glass paint should have the consistency of warm honey. If it has thickened, add warm water, one drop at a time, and stir.
2. Stained glass paints may be mixed together on a piece of aluminum foil or waxed paper to create additional colors:

Yellow + Red = Orange
Red + Green = Brown
Red + Blue = Purple
Yellow + Green = Lime
Blue + Green = Turquoise
3.
 - a. Place the plastic frame on your work surface with the raised ridges facing up. Keep the frame flat on your work surface as you paint so the stain does not pour over into the wrong sections.
 - b. Decide which sections you will fill with stained glass paint and which you will paint with the white acrylic paint.
 - c. Pick up a generous amount of glass stain on the brush. Hold the brush close to the section you wish to fill. Allow the stain to drip off the brush until the area is covered. Use the brush to gently push the stain into the smaller areas or use an eyedropper. Use the end of your paintbrush to break any bubbles in stain.
 - d. Rinse the brush when changing colors and dry it with the paper towel to avoid diluting the stains.
4. Let the completed frames dry for 24 hours before handling them.
