## Ukrainian Eggs (Pk/12)

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE STARTING



### YOUR KIT CONTAINS:

- Foam Eggs
- Tube
- Paint
- Mini Lo Temp Glue
- Sticks
- Brushes

### YOU WILL NEED:

- Containers for Water
- Toothpicks
- Lo-Temp Hot Glue Gun  
(such as GL491 sold separately)

**AGE GROUP: 12 and up**

**PREP TIME: 1 minute**

**PROJECT TIME: 60 minutes**

**PREP INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Plug in a low-temp glue gun.
2. Push a toothpick in one end of your egg. It will be easier to hold.

**PROJECT INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Choose an egg and make a design using a hot glue gun. Keep the gun about an inch away from the egg, so as not to melt the egg.
2. When cooled, cover the egg with black paint and allow to dry. You will be covering the areas of glue, too. Cover the egg completely.
3. Peel the dried glue from the egg.
4. Paint the areas where the hot glue used to be and was stripped. Use any colors except black.
5. For fine detail, use a toothpick to make dots or fine lines in your design or on the black parts. You could also use the back end of the paint brush to make dots.
6. Allow to dry.
7. Choose a tube and paint it to match your egg. Let dry.
8. Use the tube as a display pedestal for your egg.
