## Snowman Pin (Pk/24)

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE STARTING



### YOUR KIT CONTAINS:

- Pin Backs
- Glue
- Paint and Brushes
- Wooden Spoons
- String
- Felt

**AGE GROUP: 8 and up**  
**PREP TIME: 10 minutes**  
**PROJECT TIME: 30 minutes**

### YOU WILL NEED:

- Scissors
- Ruler
- Container for Water

**PREP INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Cut twenty-four 4" x 1/4" pieces of felt.
2. Cut twenty-four 2" x 2-1/4" pieces of felt.

**INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Select one wooden spoon. Paint the spoon white. Let dry. Paint a face and buttons on the snowman.
2. Select one piece of 4" x 1/4" felt and glue it around the neck of the snowman (see Figure A). Let dry.
3. Select one piece of 2" x 2-1/4" felt. Fold over approximately 3/8" from the long side.
4. Glue the felt around the top of the snowman (see Figure B). The folded part will appear as the brim of the hat. Let dry.
5. Cut a 5" piece of string. Tie the string tightly around the hat about 3/4" down from the top of the felt.
6. Make small snips around the top of the hat above the string (see Figure C).
7. Glue pinback to the back of the snowman. Let dry.

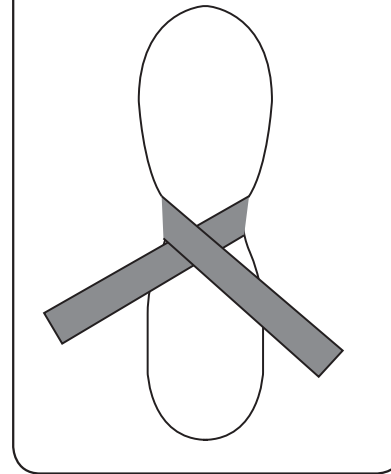

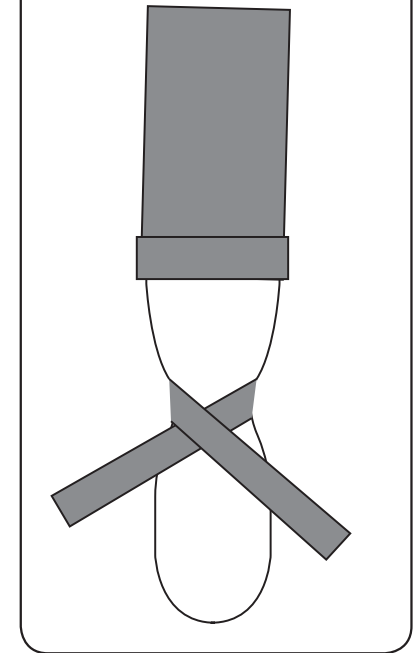
