## Spider Kit (Pk/12)

## Spider Kit (Pk/12)

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE STARTING



### YOUR KIT CONTAINS:

- Black Chenille Stems
- Black Beads
- Pink Beads
- Green Beads

**AGE GROUP: 8 and up**  
**PROJECT TIME: 30 minutes**

**YOU WILL NEED:**  
• Clean Work Surface

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**INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Thread 4 chenille stems through the large black bead to slightly less than half way. Bring the 4 ends together so that they are equal length up at the top end of the bead. (See Figure A)
2. Twist all 4 stems together once and then spread the 8 legs out.
3. On the 2 stems closest to the top of the black bead, thread the smaller black bead. This is the head. On those same 2 chenille stems, thread each of the small pink beads and push down tight to the black bead. These are the eyes.
4. Thread 3 more green beads onto the same 2 chenille stems, keeping each bead about 1-1/2" inch apart. These are the legs.
5. Thread the other green beads on each leg, with the legs having 4 beads each. Your kit may have an extra bead or 2 just in case you lose one.
6. Bend the very end of the chenille stem over to form tiny feet.
7. Bend each leg into a curve, so that the spider appears to be walking.
8. The finished spiders can be hooked together by their legs, or hooked into some web for decoration or display.
9. You may reposition the spider legs any way you wish to make it look more realistic.
