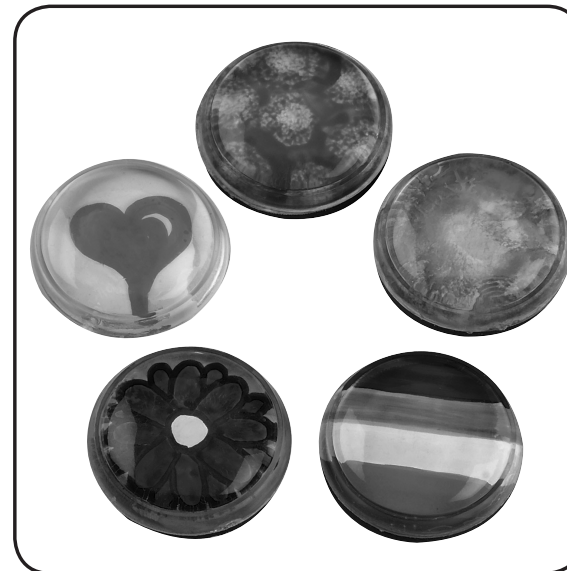

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Lay all materials out on clean work surface.
2. Using the markers, color your design on the white circle.

TIP: Place the acrylic stone on top of your design as you begin to color to see the magnifying effects.

3. Complete your design and allow time for the ink to dry.
4. Attach the adhesive magnet to the back of your white circle.
5. Carefully drop very small dots of tacky glue to the outer edge of your completed circle. Place the stone on top of the design, using caution to not smear the glue dots.

NOTE: The wet glue will distort your design image through the stone. This will disappear as it dries.

6. Allow to dry completely.
