Stuffed Football (Pk/12)

YOUR KIT CONTAINS:

- Felt Pieces
- Polyfill
- Yarn
- Needles
- Tablecloth

AGE GROUP: 8 and up **PREP TIME: 15 minutes PROJECT TIME: 60 minutes**

YOU WILL NEED:

- Scissors
- Ruler

PREP INSTRUCTIONS:

Divide the polyfil into 12 equal parts, by dividing it in half and then dividing each half in half. Repeat.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Choose which colors you want your football to be. You will need four pieces of felt for each football.
- 2. Cut four 1 yard pieces of yarn.
- 3. Thread a needle with a piece of yarn. Knot one end, making a large knot.
- 4. Take 2 pieces of felt. If you are using two colors, select one of each.
- 5. Thread into the first hole at the top of the piece, having the knot on the inside (see Figure A).
- 6. Using a whip stitch, stitch one side and tie off the end on the inside (see Figures B & C).
- 7. Pull part the side of two felt pieces not sewn (See Figure D).
- 8. Select another piece of felt. Line up the holes on the felt piece with the inside of one of the first pieces (see Figure D).
- 9. Start again with the knot on the inside of the hole at the top of the shape, as shown in Figures A and B again. When you get to the other end, sew into the end hole that already has a thread. Knot on inside.
- 10. Line up the fourth piece with the inside holes of the third piece similar to Step 9. Start at the top hole and then go into the top hole again from panel #2 to panel #4 (see Figure E).
- 11. Sew only 2/3 of the way on the 4th side.
- 12. Stuff it with the polyfill.
- 13. Sew the gap closed in the top, to bring side #2 and side #4 together. Knot the end on the inside.
