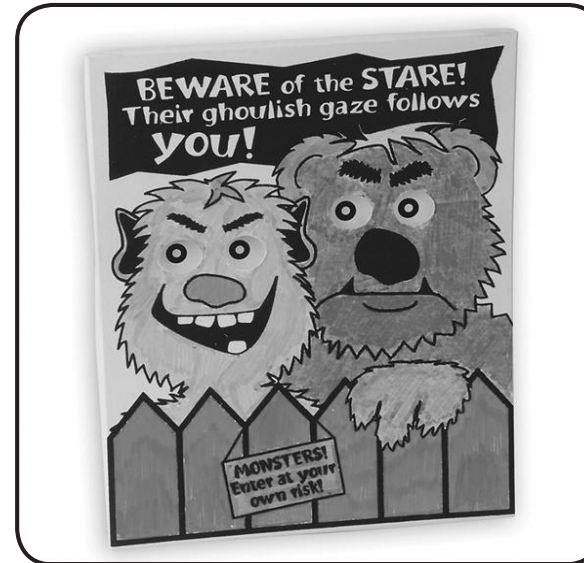

Monster Moving Eyes Kit (Pk/12)

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE STARTING



YOUR KIT CONTAINS:

- Monster Pictures
- Eyes Tabs
- Markers

AGE GROUP: 5 and up
PROJECT TIME: 30 minutes

YOU WILL NEED:

- Clear Tape

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Color the monster picture as desired.
TIP: Color the areas farthest away from your hand first to prevent getting marker on your hands.
2. The eyes tab may also be colored, but does not need to be. The more contrast there is between the eyes and the pictures, the better for the moving eyes effect.
3. Bend the four sides of the picture to make the sides stand up. You may need to press the sides up firmly or use a ruler to make the crease more defined. Tape the corners in place, so that they do not fall back to flat.
4. Bend the end tabs of the eyes strip. Place the eye strip behind the eye holes on the picture and use small pieces of tape on the edges to hold the strip in place.
TIP: If the eye holes do not match up with the eyes, then you might have the strip upside down. Try reversing it.
5. Now you are ready to enjoy the moving eyes picture. Stand the picture up or have someone hold the picture. Walk back and forth in front of the picture and watch the eyes stay with you as you move.

Optical Illusions:

An optical illusion is a visually perceived image that differs from objective reality. The information gathered in the eye is processed in the brain to give a perception that differs from the reality.

This particular illusion has to do with depth perception. Notice that if you press the eyes up to the back of the picture, so that there is no gap, then the eyes become more stationary on the picture and do not move any more.
