

Winking Owl (Pk/12)

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE STARTING



YOUR KIT CONTAINS:

- Foam Base
- Foam Circles
- Foam Triangles
- Foam Half Circles
- Foam Ears
- Foam Nose

YOU WILL NEED:

- Clean Work Surface

AGE GROUP: 6 and up

PROJECT TIME: 30 minutes

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Sort circles and triangles by color and size. Set aside.
2. Lay foam base on a flat surface.
3. Begin by placing the one red triangle near the bottom of the base in the center. (Remove adhesive backing and secure in place.) The point of the triangle should be facing down. This will resemble the feathers of the completed owl.
4. Next, add the two yellow triangles approx. ½ inch above the red, overlapping, each slightly off center from the red to the right and the left. Points should be facing the same direction as the red. They should be secured in place close enough to each other as to not expose the foam base.
5. Moving upward, continue adding the three green feathers, using the same method. You should start to see the lower body of the owl forming in a widening 'v' shape.
6. Continue with the four purple, four blue and six pink triangles to complete the owl's body.
7. Locate the 2 large blue circles. Secure them above the row of pink feathers, overlapping, to resemble the head of the owl.
8. Continue forming the eyes by stacking the two pink circles, the two white circles and the two orange circles.
9. Add the black circle to one eye and the ½ circle to the other. Your owl should be 'winking' at you!
10. Complete your owl by securing the yellow nose and the two blue ears.
