Tissue Mini Flower Pack (Pk/84)

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE STARTING



YOUR KIT CONTAINS:

- Precut Tissue Paper
- Chenille Stems

AGE GROUP: 8 and up PREP TIME: 5 minutes PROJECT TIME: 20 minutes

YOU WILL NEED:

Scissors (optional)

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Remove the first 6-layer set of colored tissue from the stack. Your flower will have multicolored layers.
- 2. Fold the set accordion style, making the folds between each petal scallop.*
- 3. Secure the folded tissue set in the chenille stem, having the color you wish to be the flower center color on top and ensuring that the stem is in the lengthwise center of the folded tissue. Pinch the stem to hold or twist ends.
- 4. Holding the folded tissue in both hands, fan out the petals. Curl the petal ends up to hold the fan open.
- 5. Holding the tissue in both hands, gently lift up each top petal one by one to form the centermost part of the flower. Repeat this for the second layer of petals and continue until the flower is complete. Final arrangement of the individual petals can be done now that the basic flower shape has been formed.

Repeat the preceding steps for the rest of the colored flowers, setting aside the white sheets that separate each colored tissue set. Finally, stacking the white tissue together in groups of 6 sheets, make the white tissue flowers.

*Alternate petal shapes may be cut at this point. See the illustrations for two possibilities.
