Fuzzy Beaded Dragonfly Kit (Pk/12)

- Ring
- Cord



AGE GROUP: 10 and up
PROJECT TIME: 45 minutes

YOU WILL NEED:

- Scissors
- Glue (optional)

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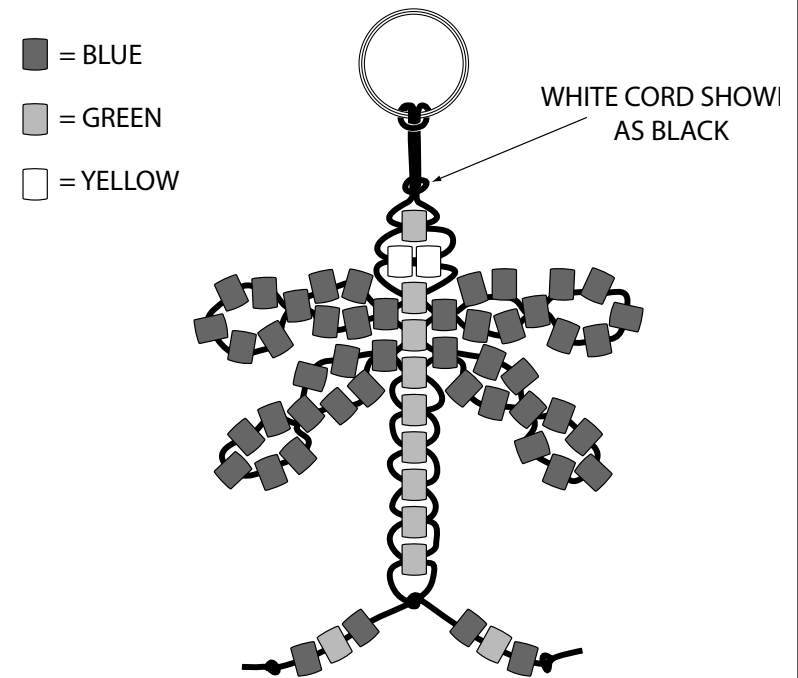
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INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Each packet contains: 2 yellow beads, 11 green beads, 4 dark blue beads, and 42 light blue beads, cord and a ring. Your packet may have extra beads in it in case you lose one. Set aside the beads.
2. Take the piece of cord and fold it in half. Thread the half way loop into the ring and bring the ends through, pull down to tighten the loop onto the ring.
3. Begin to string the beads: First one green bead is strung through one cord end and then bring the second cord end through the bead from the opposite direction. See figure A.
4. Pull both cords so that the bead is tight up to the ring.
5. Second row: thread 2 yellow beads through one cord and then put the second cord through the same beads from the opposite direction. Pull tight.
6. Third row is one green bead, same method.
7. **TIP:** When threading the wings, leave the beads loose on the cord, so that you can get the end of the cords woven back into the beads. Then pull all the beads up tight to the body after they are all finished getting strung onto the cord.
8. Refer to the bead diagram to continue forming the dragonfly body and wings. The first wing is formed by stringing on 9 blue beads. Bring that same cord back through bead #4. Then string on bead #10 and 11. Bring the cord through blue bead #1 again. Repeat for the other wing.
9. Thread on one more green bead and pull tight.
10. You are now ready to form the lower portion of each wing, by repeating step 7 again.

11. After completing the blue wings, continue down the center green beads body.
12. Once the body and wings are formed, tie a knot to secure the beads in place, at the end of the body.
13. Measure approx 1 inch down the cord and tie a knot in the same spot. Thread on one dark blue, one green and one more dark blue beads. Tie another knot after the 3 beads to secure in place. Trim the cord end to desired length. You may wish to put a dab of glue on the end to secure the knot.
14. Repeat step 9 for the other cord. This creates the tails.
