INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Plan out how you want to decorate your elephant and select your paint colors.

TIP: You can use a pencil and lightly sketch out your design before you start to paint.

2. Use water to thin out the paint, a few drops at a time. This will help give better paint coverage as the fuzzy elephant surface is very absorbent and the paint will flow much easier.
3. Paint your elephant as planned, keeping the head and body separate until complete and dry.
4. Slide the hook on the neck into the loop of the body so that the head bobbles. You're done! Great job!
