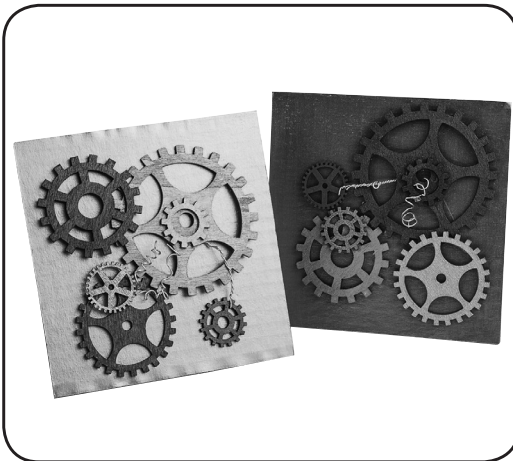

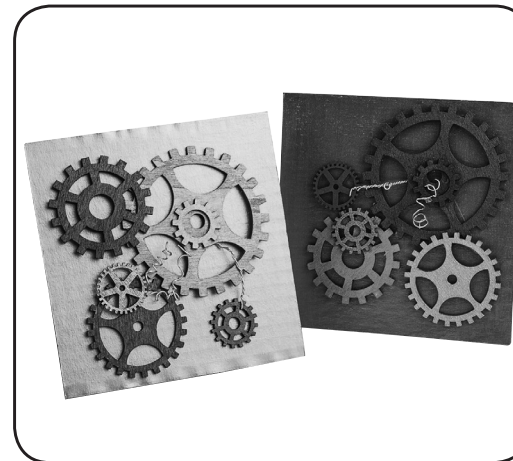

- 1 Collage Base
- 1 each of the six Gear Shapes
- 1 Piece of Wire
- 1 Brush
- Scrap Paper
- 1 Cup Water/Paper Towel
- 1 Paper Plate for paint mixing
- The metallic paint and glue will be shared among the group

PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS:

- To keep things neat, give everyone a scrap piece of paper to paint/dry their gears on.
- If time permits, have the group trace the edges of the gears with pencil onto the base painted collage boards. Next, paint in the shapes with various metallic tones to make an exciting collage background to build upon.

TIP: Mix the metallic paint with small amounts of black paint to create new tones and contrast!

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Plan a design for your collage: Brainstorm by laying out the gear shapes on the unfinished base before you start.
2. Paint the front and sides of the cardboard base (smooth side) and set aside to dry.
3. Paint the wooden gear shapes and let dry. We found two coats of paint works well.
4. Use the gears and wire to create your collage, overlapping the various sized gears as you wish. Glue down the gears into place.

TIP: You can wrap your wire around the paint brush handle to make a spring and/or weave through the gears.

5. To really make your design pop; make a bold border around the edge of your collage base using a black marker for extra contrast.
You're done, Great job!

DISPLAY SUGGESTIONS: Use 2-3 pieces of rolled masking tape on the back of your collage or create a hanger out of a piece of duck tape, or adhere magnets to the back.
