Foam Rainbow Mobile (Pk/48)

- Foam Rainbow Strips in Assorted Colors
- White Sticky Back Clouds Shapes
- Light Blue Sticky Back Raindrop Circles
- String

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Kit may contain silicone gel packets, which should be removed before use.

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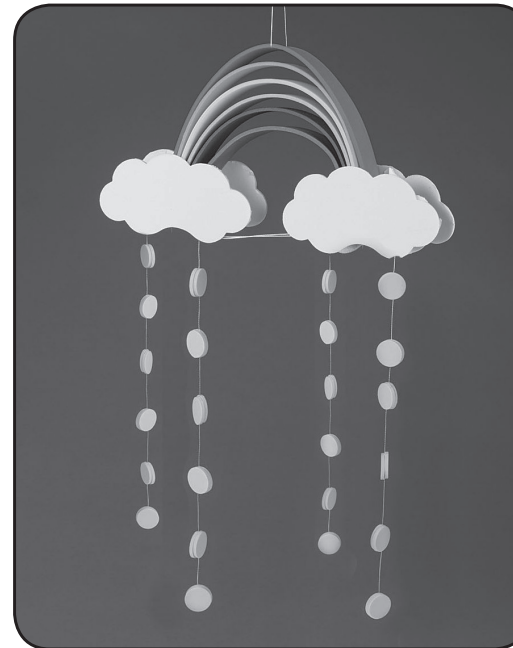
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PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS: It helps to pre-cut the string into 28" lengths. **TIP:** The string is thin so to make handling easier, roll a tiny piece of clear tape on the ends like a needle.

EVERYONE WILL NEED:

- 2 Pieces of String, each 28" long
- 32 Sticky Back Light Blue Circles
- 6 Rainbow Foam Strips, 1 of each color
- 4 White Sticky Back Foam Clouds

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Take all 6 strips of the rainbow strips and line up the ends on one side so the holes match up.
2. Take one of the 28" pieces of string and thread through the holes of all 6 rainbow strip. Pull through until you have equal lengths hanging on each side. Tie together with a tight double knot.
3. Leave one string hanging and pull the other over to the opposite side of the rainbow strips. Thread through all 6 holes and tie together with another double knot. This should pull the foam strips into an arc, forming your rainbow.
4. Take the other 28" piece of string and cut off a 6" piece. Use this small piece to loop around the center of the red foam strip and knot together. Use this loop as a hanger for your finished rainbow.
5. Take your last piece of string and cut in half. Peel the paper backing from one white foam cloud and stick the end of one string to the bottom center. Then stick both together to the front center of one side of your rainbow. See image of finished product for placement.
6. Repeat step 5 with your second foam cloud and your last piece of string, and stick to the opposite side of your rainbow.
7. The last 2 cloud shapes should stick to the back side of your rainbow making your finished project visible from all sides like a mobile. See image of finished product for placement.
8. Last, on all 4 strings that are hanging down, peel and stick the light blue foam circles together with the string in-between, to look like raindrops falling from the clouds.

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
