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NOTE TO THE INSTRUCTOR:

This project is designed to help kids “Pay It Forward” being a good citizen of the community. Here are some suggestions to make this project more meaningful.

Before you get started:

- Have a conversation with the group about ways that people show care in their community.
- Have a conversation about the importance of kids being good citizens of their community. This project allows each person to make that statement!
- Have a conversation with the group about ways that kids can care for the Earth (recycle, trash pick-up, planting trees or a garden, etc.)
- Take this to the next level: Develop a project that the group can do together to make the community or Earth a better place. Brainstorm ideas with the group, list them on a paper and have the group vote. Possible ideas include a food or clothing drive or a clean up day in a local park!

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Using the markers, color in the globe.
2. Decorate around the globe. Kids can trace their hands around the globe, draw a heart around the globe or draw rays coming out. Other ideas include drawing a pattern of hearts, or smiley faces, circling around the globe. Be creative!
3. Decorate the sign with markers and sequins.

TIP: We recommend putting glue down first and sprinkling the sequins over the glued area then shaking off the excess over the paper plate.

4. If you are using optional decorations, glue them on as well.
Let dry.

Ideas on How to Share the Signs:

- Earth Day every day! Post the signs by recycle bin, photocopiers or other areas where people can use a reminder to care for the Earth!
- Display a large picture of the globe or picture from your local community. Post the signs all around this to make a statement of caring and a neat community art project!

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
