## Fuzzy Bead Chipmunk (Pk/12)

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE STARTING



**AGE GROUP: 8 and up**  
**PROJECT TIME: 20 minutes**

### YOUR KIT CONTAINS:

- Fuzzy Pony Beads
- Bead Pattern
- Black Cotton Cord
- Wiggly Eyes
- Split Rings
- Glue

### YOU WILL NEED:

- Strong Tape
- Scissors
- Paper Plates (Optional)
- Flat Work Surface

**PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS:**

Make photocopies of the bead pattern so that everyone has a copy to reference. We found that giving everyone a small paper plate was very helpful in preventing beads from getting lost or rolling off the table. All of the pieces/parts that each person will need to make a fuzzy bead chipmunk are individually packaged to make things easy for you!

**INSTRUCTIONS:**

- Carefully empty out your plastic bags to see all the components you will be using. Unravel the hank of black cord and match up the ends to find the middle loop. Put the loop on one side of the split ring; Next, pass the two loose ends through the loop on the other side (See Figure A). Pull tight and firmly tape down to your work surface.
- Keep the bead diagram out and visible so that you can follow along as you make your project. To begin the First Row, string 1 tan bead onto one cord. String the other cord through the same tan bead and pull both ends tight so the beads are tight up against the ring/beginning loop that you have taped down (See Figure A).
- Second Row- Same method as above. Follow the bead pattern using 2 brown beads. Pull tight up against row one.
- Third Row- Same method as above. Follow the bead pattern using 1 tan and 2 brown beads in the order shown. Pull tight up against row two.
- Now you need to make the chipmunk's back legs. You will use only one cord per side instead of two. String 3 brown beads onto one cord. Follow the bead pattern and bring that same cord back through the first brown beads (See Figure A). Repeat this process with the opposite cord and 3 more brown beads to make the second back leg. Pull both sides tight by holding the 1st brown bead in place while you pull the single cord towards the center.
- Fourth Row- Same method as in steps 2-4. Follow the bead pattern using 2 tan beads, 2 brown beads and 1 black bead in the order shown on the pattern. Pull tight up against row three.
- Fifth Row- Same method as above. Follow the bead pattern using 2 tan beads, 2 brown beads, and 2 black beads in the order shown on the pattern. Pull tight up against row four.
- Sixth Row- Same method as above. Follow the bead pattern using 2 tan beads, 2 brown beads and 1 black bead in the order shown on the pattern. Pull tight up against row five.
- Now you need to make the chipmunks' front legs. You will use only one cord per side instead of two. String 2 brown beads onto one cord, follow the bead pattern and bring that same cord back through the first brown bead (See Figure A). Repeat this process with the opposite cord and 2 more brown beads to make the second front leg. Pull both sides tight by holding the 1st brown bead in place while you pull the single cord towards the center.

- Seventh Row- Same method as in steps 6-8. Follow the bead pattern using 2 tan beads and 2 brown beads in the order shown on the pattern. Pull tight up against row six.
- Eighth Row- Same method as above. Follow the bead pattern using 3 brown beads. Pull tight up against row seven.
- Ninth Row- Same method as above. Follow the bead pattern using 2 brown beads and 2 black beads in the order shown on the pattern. Pull tight up against row eight.
- Tenth Row- Same method as above follow the bead pattern using 2 brown beads and 1 black. Pull tight up against row nine.
- Make sure all the rows are pulled tightly together and tie the two cords together with a strong knot. Snip off the excess cord and apply a small dab of glue over the knot so it won't slip loose. Let dry.
- Glue on the wiggly eyes and let dry. Remove the tape from the ring/start and you're done!
