Sand Art Seashell Bottle Necklaces (Pk/12)

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE STARTING



YOUR KIT CONTAINS:

- Colored Sand Packets
- Plastic Seashell Bottles
- Cord
- Plastic Bottle Tops
- Plastic Funnel

YOU WILL NEED:

- Scissors
- Glue (optional)

AGE GROUP: 7 and up

PROJECT TIME: 20 minutes

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Snip the corner of each colored sand packet.
2. Place the plastic funnel into the top of the seashell bottle.
3. Choose a color sand, and slowly pour the sand into the bottle, adding as much as desired.
4. Change colored sand, and repeat process until the whole bottle is filled with sand.
5. Gently tap the bottle on the table to make sand compact in bottle. You will probably need to add more sand to the bottle after doing this.
6. Repeat this process until completely compact.
7. Place the plastic cap onto the seashell bottle. You may wish to glue the top of the bottle and cap.
8. Thread the cord provided through the hole in the cap.
9. Your project is complete!

TIP: Put a drop of glue on the inside of the cap before closing to prevent opening or spilling.
