YOUR KIT CONTAINS:

- Preassembled Bobblehead Dogs
- Acrylic Paint
- Paint Brushes

YOU WILL NEED:

- Containers for Water
- Paper Towels

AGE GROUP: 6 and up

PROJECT TIME: 30 minutes

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Plan out how you want to decorate your dog and select your paint colors.
2. Use water to thin out the paint, a few drops at a time. This will help give better paint coverage as the dog is very absorbent.
3. Start by painting a base coat, keeping the dog and base and head separate for now.
4. Continue painting with additional colors for detail.
TIP: Mix colors to create desired tints and shades.
5. Allow to dry completely.
6. Slide the hook on the neck into the loop on the body, so that the head bobbles. You're done! Great job!
