Craft Stick Lantern (Pk/12)

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE STARTING



YOUR KIT CONTAINS:

- Craft Sticks
- Assorted Wood Shapes
- Wax Paper Pieces
- Tacky Glue
- Faux candle tea lights

AGE GROUP: 8 and up
PREP TIME: 5 minutes
PROJECT TIME: 45 minutes

YOU WILL NEED:

- Ruler
- Scissors

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Lay the pieces out on your covered work area. Lay the wax paper down horizontally in front of you. **TIP:** Tape it to the table to prevent it from moving.
2. Select 16 craft sticks. Apply a small amount of glue to the back of the first one and lay it vertically onto the left edge of the wax paper – 1/8 inch from the edge.
3. Continue gluing the next 3 craft sticks onto the wax paper to form a square. The top and bottom sticks should be up against the edge of the paper with no overlap and the left and right sticks should be snug against the others to create a perfect square. **TIP:** Use a ruler or other hard straight object to help create the square.
4. See Figure A. Using the glue, create 3 more squares with the remaining craft sticks. Place them snug against each other on the wax paper – this will be important when forming your lantern. Trim the remaining paper to approx 1/8 inch.
5. While the four squares are drying, choose assorted wood shapes to decorate your lantern. Apply small amounts of glue to each shape and glue to the wax paper to create designs within each of the four squares. Allow to dry.
6. Once dry, roll or fold up the wax paper so the ends meet and the sticks are on the outside. The sticks and the paper between the squares creates a “box.”
7. Apply a small amount of glue to the strip of extra paper on the side edge and glue together behind the existing craft sticks. Allow to dry.
8. Stand the lantern up and insert faux candle tea light.
IMPORTANT: Do not use open flame inside your lantern. Use only the tea lights provided.
