YOU WILL NEED:

- Clothespins (optional)
- Masking Tape (optional)

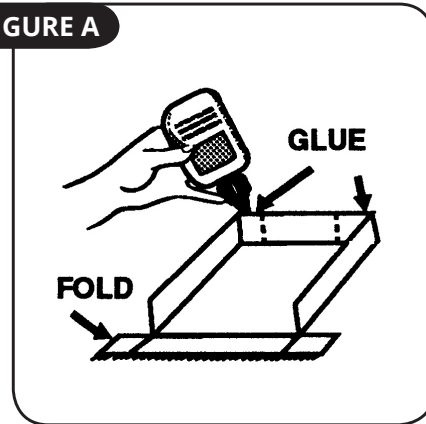
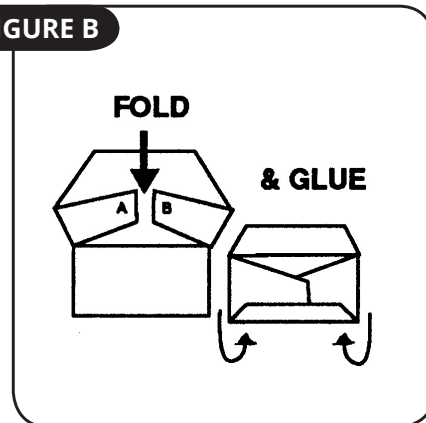
INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Take one shell Treasure box lid, fold and glue as shown in Figure A.
2. Take shell treasure box, fold tabs A and B together and glue. Take the large tab and glue over tabs A and B (see Figure B).

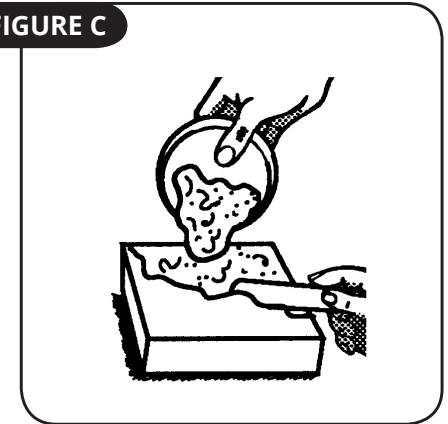
HELPFUL HINTS:

Your may wish to use a rubber band or clothespin to clamp the box while the glue is drying.

3. Paint the outside of the box and lid with a color of your choice. Let dry.
4. Mix glue and sand to a pasty consistency, similar to raw cookie dough.

5. Use a craftstick to spread glue mixture onto the lid. Make the sand 1/8" to 1/4" thick on top of the lid. Spread mixture to the edges and wipe any spillovers off the sides of the lid (see Figure C).
6. Take the shells and press into the sand mixture. Let dry.

HELPFUL HINTS: Mask off the lid with tape to keep the sand from running down the side of the lid (see Figure D).
