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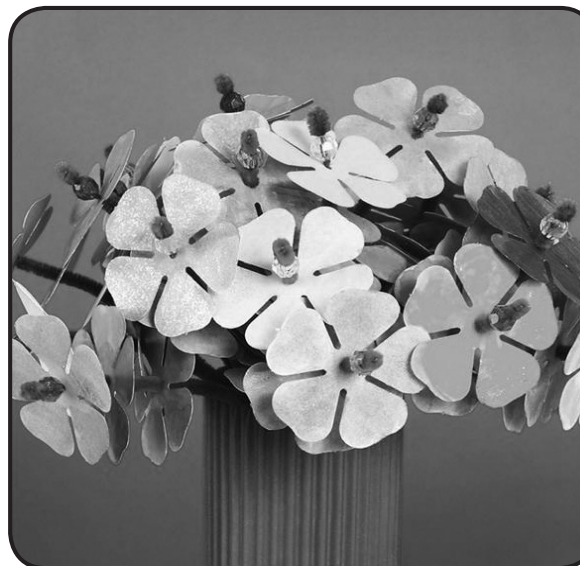
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Watercolor Flowers (Pk/300)

- Chenille Stems

YOU WILL NEED:

- Containers of Water
- Paper Plate or Palette

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INSTRUCTIONS:**PLEASE NOTE:**

The watercolors included in this kit are concentrated colors. You will only need a small spot of paint with water to paint your flower. Use the plate or palette to blend colors or to make different shades.

1. Select a flower and paint it with the watercolors. Let dry.
2. Flip your flower over and paint the back side of the flower. Let dry.
3. Paint your flower with glitter glaze. You can also use the glitter glaze for added accents. Let dry.
4. Take a chenille stem and one bead. Thread the bead onto the chenille stem. Leave about 1/2" of the chenille stem (see Figure A).
5. Bend the 1/2" end of the chenille stem over. The tip of the chenille stem should touch the top of the bead (see Figure B).
6. Carefully thread the flower onto the chenille stem behind the bead (see Figure C).
