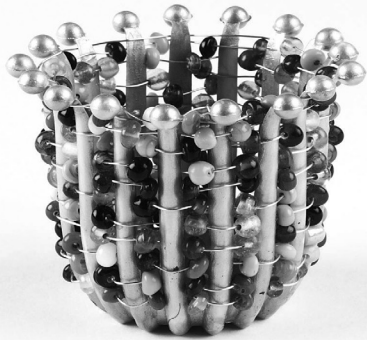

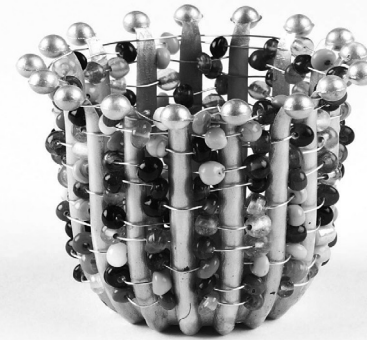

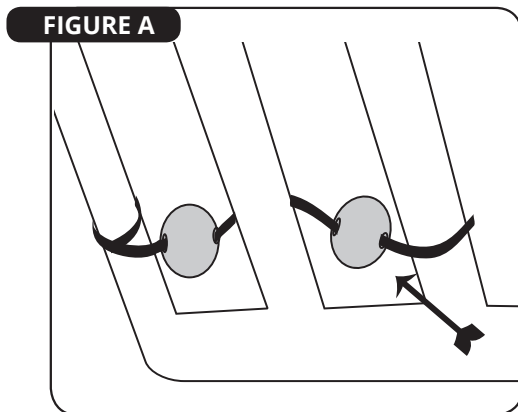

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Paint the inside and outside of the plastic weaving pot. Let dry.
2. Cut four peices of one yard wire.
3. Attach one end of wire onto the bottom of a post on the plastic weaving pot with a knot (twist the end to avoid the sharp point).
4. Slip on one bead. Weave the wire to the back of the post. Come to the front and slip on another bead (see Figure A).
5. Continue weaving in and out and adding beads until you reach the end.
6. To add a new wire, twist two ends together to continue weaving. Do the same step for 3rd and 4th wires until you have woven to the top of the plastic weaving pot.
7. To end: feed the wire to the inside of the plastic weaving pot and tuck behind an existing wire.
